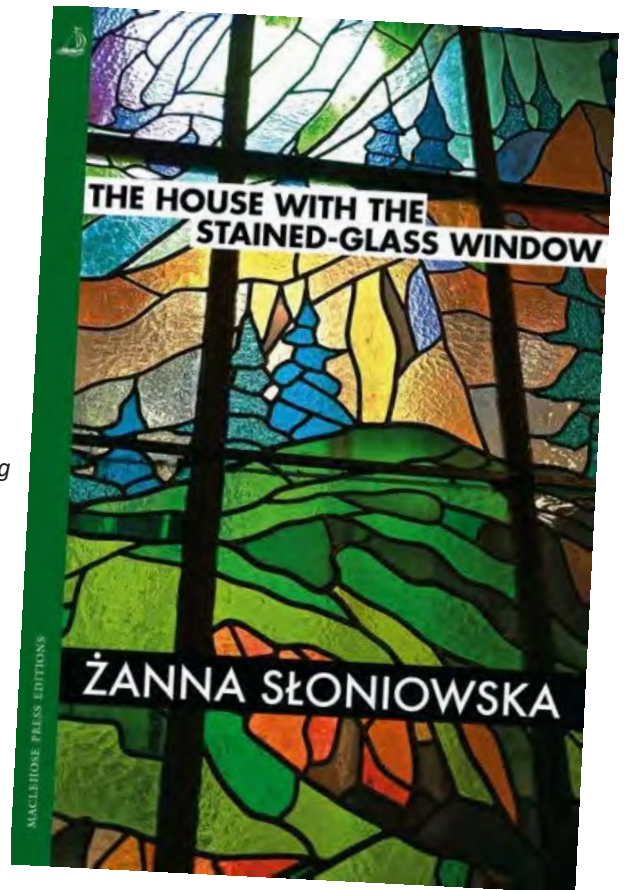
Book Discussion:
